Warning

Before cleaning, installing or uninstalling your suppressor, verify that the magazine is out of the firearm and that the firearm is unloaded. Failure to do so, may result in serious injury or death. Your suppressor will become hot while in use, when installing or uninstalling the suppressor use the proper protective gear. Place the suppressor in an area where it will not come in contact with flammable material. Verify bore alignment prior to use. This suppressor has caliber and barrel length restrictions, failure to follow these restrictions will void your warranty and may lead to serious injury or death.

- Verify bore alignment prior to use.
- Ensure that the suppressor is always well tightened.
- Failure to follow caliber restrictions will void your warranty.

Cleaning

This suppressor is a hybrid sealed suppressor. At any time you feel your suppressor needs to be cleaned please contact us for instructions. With use on Short Barreled firearms, a large amount of unburned gunpowder can build up inside the suppressor, meaning it will need to be cleaned after long term use.
